Install Frontier bumper support bracket (see drawing) behind bumper and to the side of frame (use existing hole in frame). Insert bolt and slide bumper support bracket forward to the backside of the chrome

bumper. DO NOT REMOVE BUMPER! Tighten bolt.

Step 1: (1500, Tahoe, Sub series truck)

Step 1: (1500HD & 2500LD series truck)

Remove lower bumper support bolt located on the engine side of frame (see drawing). Install Frontier bumper support bracket behind bumper and to the side of frame (see drawing). Insert bolt and slide bumper support bracket forward to the backside of the chrome bumper. Tighten bolt.

- Step 2: Connect frame support bracket to frame (use appropriate bracket depending on vehicle model).
- **Step 3**: Install bottom of grille guard to frame support bracket.
- Step 4: Align grille guard to truck and drill 1/2 inch hole through chrome bumper and bumper support bracket installed in step 1 (Note 1500 bracket is pre-punched).
- Step 5: Insert ½" X 1-3/4" bolts through grille guard, chrome bumper, and bumper support bracket. Check alignment of grille guard to truck and tighten all bolts.
