

RANGE ROVER WINCH BULL BAR



TOOLS REQUIRED -


Basic Took Kit 1/2" Capacity drill & 1/2" drill bit Jigsaw for vehicles with spoiler.

PROCEDURE - REFER TO WINCH FITMENT DETAILS BEFORE PROCEEDING.

- 1. Remove original bumper bar, stays and registration plate. Remove front spoiler if fitted.
- 2. Lift bull bar into position on chassis rails and align mounting holes.
- 3. Fit 4 off 4 1/2" x 1/2" bolts to the 4 holes closest to the bull bar. Fit washers, spring washers, nuts and tighten.
- 4. Using bull bar as guide, drill the 2 remaining holes out to 1/2" and fit 4 1/2" x 1/2" bolts using 70mmx 40mm special washers provided. See diagram below. Fit washers, spring washers, nuts and tighten.



- 5. For vehicles fitted with front spoiler, modify the spoiler as per diagram below using jigsaw, and refit to pre-welded brackets behind bull bar using:
 - 4 1 1/4" x 3/8" UNC bolts, nuts, washers and spring washers. 2-1 1/2" x 1/2" UNC bolts, nuts, washers and
 - spring washers.
 - $2 50 \times 50 \times 14$ mm square washers (for centre holes of spoiler brackets)
- Refit registration plate and fit rubber grommets to holes in body now exposed, ie: where the bumper bar rubber and caps originally attached to.

WINCH AND ROLLER FAIRLEAD FITMENT

New mounting holes must be drilled in the roller fairlead to line up with winch mounting holes in bull bar.

- Remove circlips which retain side pins.
- Remove side pins and side rollers from roller fairlead.

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- Position roller fairlead hard up against roller fairlead bracket.
- 4. From rear of bar using holes in bull bar as a guide, mark out new hole positions on roller fairlead and drill out to 1/2"
- 5. Position winch on top of a 20 litre or 60 litre drum with the winch mounting holes facing upwards. Remove winch control box from winch, and replace winch to control box cables with new cables provided. On the 10,000lb winch models, the thermal cut out wire will also need to be extended with cable and insulating green sleeve provided. Do not refit control box to winch.
- 6. On 80001b and 90001b winch models, a spacer kit will be required Pt. No. 3500020. This spacer kit moves the winch back 8mm to allow installation. See separate instructions.
- 7. Place the bull bar on top of the winch and align mounting holes. Using bolts supplied from winch kit and 7/16" washers supplied in ARB kit, fit and finger tighten the 2 upper bolts.
- 8. Place roller fairlead in position over two lower holes, insert bolts and finger tighten.
- Ensure winch and roller fairlead are aligned and tighten all bolts.
- Refit winch control box to welded on tag on bull bar.
- 11. Using 6" bolts supplied, place a flat washer under the head of both bolts and insert bolts through roller fairlead bracket and side rollers. Fit nyloc nuts and tighten so that rollers turn freely.
- 12. Fit bull bar to vehicle following procedure on page 1.
- 13. Wire up winch as per winch manual instructions.
- 14. Check operation of winch as per winch manual.
