
PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Remove the lower bumper front valance by removing the two M6 bolts at the ends and prying out the center pins of the plastic retaining clips with a flat head screwdriver. See **Figure 1** for reference.
- 3. On vehicles with factory tow hooks: Start the installation on the driver side, behind the front bumper. Remove the factory tow hook. See Figure 1 for reference. Remove the two hex nuts on the bottom of the bumper bracket securing the 2-bolt tow hook mounting bracket to the frame.
- 4. On vehicles <u>without</u> factory tow hooks: <u>For 2009 2012 vehicles</u>, remove the plastic fill panel on the front bumper by removing the 2-piece plastic clips at the top of the panel. See **Figure 2** for reference. <u>For 2013+ vehicles</u> remove the two plastic bumper inserts that are attached with (4) M6 fasteners from the inside of the bumper. Next, from behind the driver side of the front bumper, remove the (2) hex nuts on the bottom of the bumper bracket securing the bumper to the frame. See **Figure 3** for reference. <u>Note</u>: Use a flat-head screwdriver to first pop the center pin out to release the clip.









- 5. Drive the (2) carriage bolts in the bumper bracket out of the bracket by striking the end of the bolts with a hammer. See **Figure 4** for reference. Discard the tin retaining washers.
- 6. Insert the Driver Side Mounting Bracket into the opening in the front of the bumper and line up the (2) mounting holes with the holes in the bumper bracket. For vehicles without tow hooks, re-use the factory carriage bolts and nuts to secure these brackets. For vehicles with tow hooks, replace the factory carriage bolts and nuts with the supplied (2) medium M12 hex bolts (Item 17) and (2) M12 flat washers (Item 15 or 18). Place them through the Driver Side Frame Mounting Bracket and Bumper Bracket (the factory nuts will be re-used). See Figure 5. for reference. Re-install the factory tow hook before attaching the nuts. Attach all hardware loosely.







7. Remove the factory M10 flange bolt from the bottom of the bumper located beneath the area of the tow hook pocket. Use the factory bolt to loosely attach the Lower Mounting Bracket. See **Figure 6** for reference.






- 8. Use (1) long M12 hex bolt, (1) M12 large flat washer, (1) M12 regular flat washer, (1) M12 lock washer, and (1) M12 hex nut to loosely attach the Support Strap to the side of the frame tower. The M12 large flat washer should be placed on the side of the tower opposite the support strap. See **Figures 7, 8, & 10** for reference.
- 9. Repeat steps 2 through 8 for passenger side Mounting Bracket installation.






- 10. With assistance, position the Grille Guard Base up to the Frame Mounting Brackets and the Lower Mounting Brackets. Use the included (4) M12 button head bolts, (8) M12 flat washers, (4) M12 lock washers, and (4) M12 hex nuts to loosely attach the Grille Guard Base to the Frame Mounting Brackets. See **Figures 9 & 10** for reference.
- 11. Align the holes and loosely attach the Grille Guard Base to the Bottom Mounting Brackets using (2) M12 button head bolts, (4) M12 flat washers, (2) M12 lock washers and (2) M12 hex nuts. See **Figures 9 & 10** for reference.
- 12. With assistance, align and adjust the Grille Guard Base and tighten all hardware, including the tow hook hardware. <u>On vehicles without factory tow hooks</u>: The plastic fill panel in the front bumper removed in **Step 3** may be discarded or can be reinstalled but will require trimming to clear the Frame Mounting Brackets. Once modified, use the factory hardware to reinstall (on 2013+ vehicles only (2) of the (4) bolts may be re-used).
- 13. Trim the lower valance to fit around the lower mounting brackets and re-install using factory hardware.






14. Using supplied M8 hardware, bolt the Driver and Passenger Wings to the Grille Guard Base. See Figure 11 for reference.
15. Adjust the Grille Guard Base, HDX Wings, and mounting brackets as necessary. Tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs. and M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.
