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



III. VEHICLE PREPARATION

- 1. Park vehicle on level surface.
- 2. Engage parking brake and disconnect battery.
- 3. Using blue masking tape, mask along the profile of your truck above the bumper. This will help protect your truck from any accidental scratches.



IV. REMOVAL OF OE BUMPER

1. Using trim tool, remove nine Christmas trees attaching the engine shroud.



2. Using T15 Torx bit, remove two screws attaching hood latch release lever to truck. DO NOT CLOSE HOOD!




- 3. Remove engine shroud and temporarily replace hood latch release lever and screws.
- 4. Using a 10mm socket, remove four bolts attaching the top of the grill to the truck.



5. If equipped with a camera, unplug it. The plug is located on the right side of the grille next to the headlight. You will need to pull out on the top of the grille to access the plug.




- 6. Use blue masking tape to tape around plastic trim pieces under headlights. Gently pull out on top of grille to release tabs. Then gently pull out on bottom of grille to remove. Set aside.
- 7. Using 15mm socket, remove three bolts attaching lower bumper brace to truck. Remove brace and set aside. (both sides)





8. If equipped with fog lights or sensors, unplug harness. Plug is located next to the right headlight.



9. If equipped with engine block heater, unplug harness. Plug is located next to the left headlight.



10. Using an 18mm socket, remove four bolts attaching bumper to truck. Remove bumper and set aside.






11. Using trim tool, remove two Christmas trees attaching tow hook trim pieces to truck.



12. Using an 18mm wrench and socket, remove two bolts attaching tow hooks to frame. Remove tow hook and set aside. (both sides)



13. Using 7mm socket, remove four bolts attaching louvers to OE bumper mounts.





14. Using 15mm socket, remove eight bolts attaching OE bumper mounts to frame. Set mounts aside.



I. INSTALLATION OF HAMMERHEAD BUMPER

- 1. Reinstall grill and engine shroud.
- 2. Install all lights and sensors in Hammerhead bumper at this time. Use included Bar mount brackets (601-56-2958 and 2959) and Hardware kit #57 to attach 20" bar in bumper to mount in bumper. Use hole in bracket and bumper that works best with your light bar. Tighten bolts from hardware kit #57 with 7/16" socket and wrench.



2958-2959 brackets






3. Layout frame mounts, louver mounts, and hardware kit as shown.



4. Using OE hardware, install frame mounts and louver mounts as shown.



- 5. Using two hardware kit # 57s install OE louver on mounts.
- 6. Layout weldnut tab 3 (601-56-2868) and hardware from hardware kit #58 as shown. You will use $\sin \frac{1}{2}$ " -13x1.5" bolts, $\sin \frac{1}{2}$ " flat washers, and $\sin \frac{1}{2}$ " lock washers to attach your Hammerhead bumper to the frame mounts.





7. Using a hoist or a few friends, attach bumper to frame mounts using hardware. Put bolts in from the outside through Hammerhead frame mounts. Use the weldnut tab on the inside. Start all bolts before aligning bumper. Align bumper a minimum of ¼" below headlights. When truck flexes off-road, this distance allows your bumper and body to have clearance. Tighten bolts with ¾" socket or wrench. Tighten frame mount bolts at this time.

10. Trim inner fenders to match bumper.
