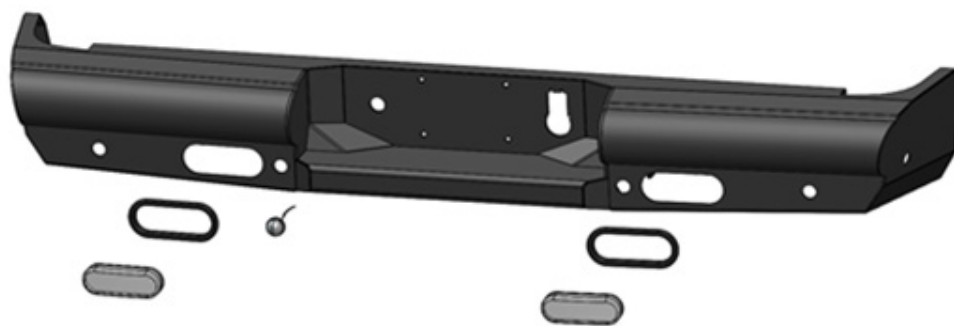

Failure to fully account for all components before beginning installation may leave vehicle immobile until part is acquired. Refer to the next pages as an inventory check.

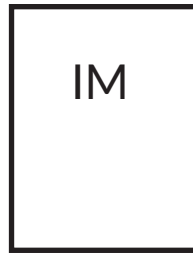

ASSISTANCE

We recommend two people perform the installation as items are heavy and may need to be held in place while installing.

ORGANIZATION

Disassemble the vehicle where you can catalog and store everything. We suggest labeling and bagging all the OEM bolts when removing from the vehicle. Failure to keep track of parts could lead to an inability to properly reinstall components.

DISASSEMBLY

1. Using a 15mm socket wrench, remove the two (2) nuts from behind the license plate. (Figure 1)

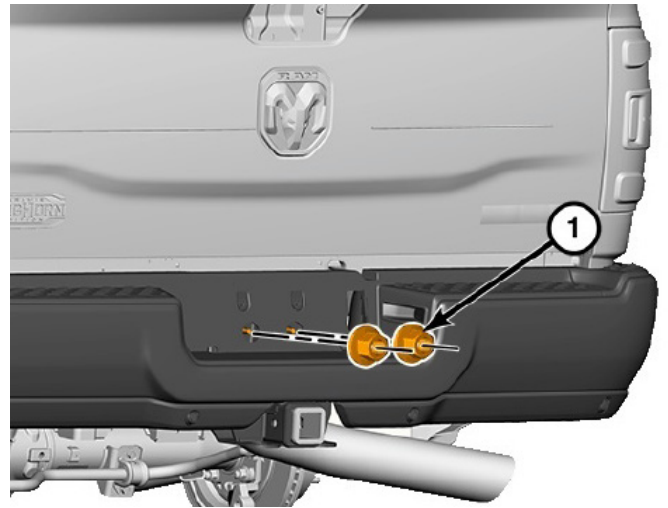

2. Disconnect the sensor and trailer plug harness by pulling back the red tab and separating the connectors. (Figure 2)

3. Using a 15mm socket wrench, remove the two (2) bolts connecting the bumper to the frame on both the driver and passenger side. (Figure 3)

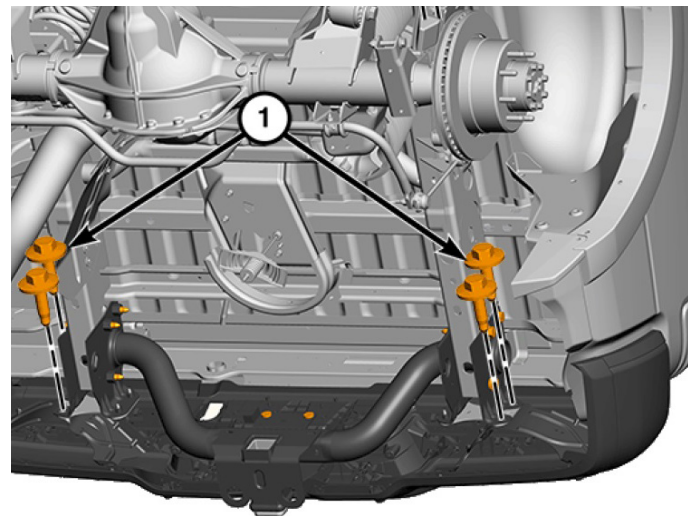

4. With assistance, remove the bumper from the truck. Using a 10mm socket wrench, remove the two (2) bolts and support plates from the frame rails on both the driver and passenger side. (Figure 4, #1)

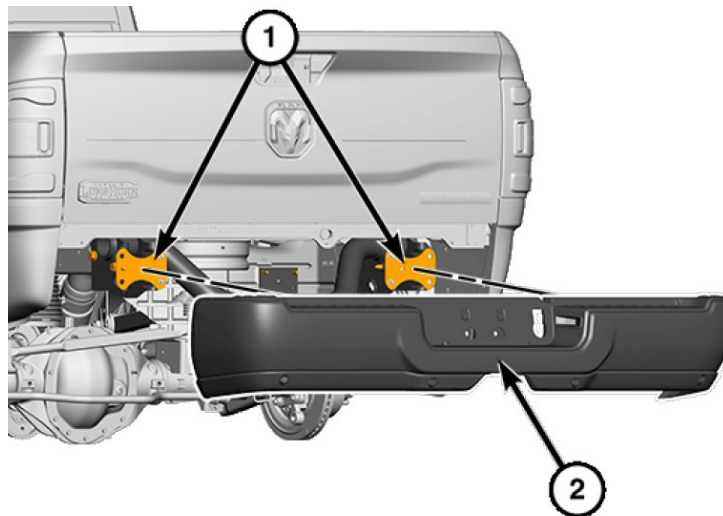

5. With the bumper off the truck, carefully unplug the wire harness from the trailer plug, license plate lights, keyless entry sensor and sensors. Using a plastic panel pry tool, remove the fasteners holding the harness to the OEM bumper. Remove the harness from the bumper and set aside for later use. (Figure 5-6)

6. Carefully remove the four (4) sensors from the OEM bumper by separating the fastening clips (Figure 7, #1) and lifting the sensor (Figure 7, #2) out of its housing.

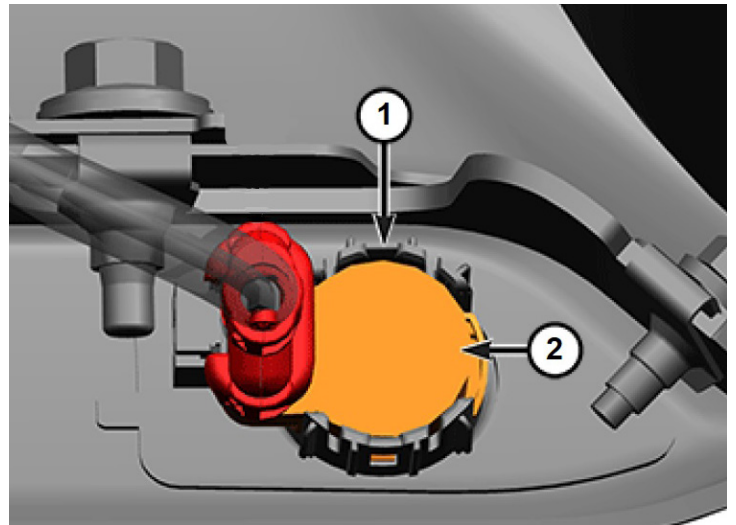

7. Using a 10mm socket wrench, remove the bolt holding the license plate lights in place and remove the lights from the OEM bumper. (Figure 8)

8. If equipped, using a T20 torx bit, remove the keyless entry sensor from the OEM bumper. (Figure 9)

9. Remove the trailer plug from the OEM bumper by depressing the two (2) metal clips on the sides and pushing the plug out of the bumper. (Figure 10)

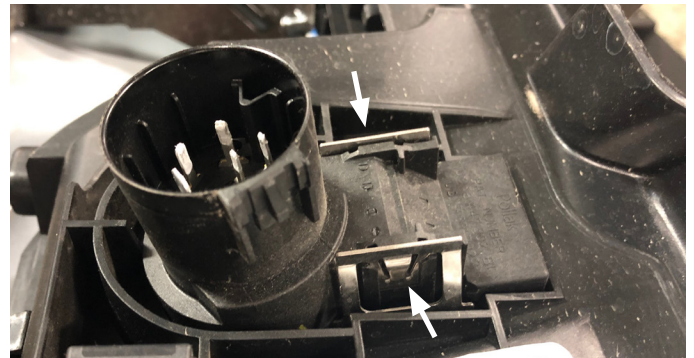

10. Figure 11 shows the components that will be used in your new Fab Fours bumper.

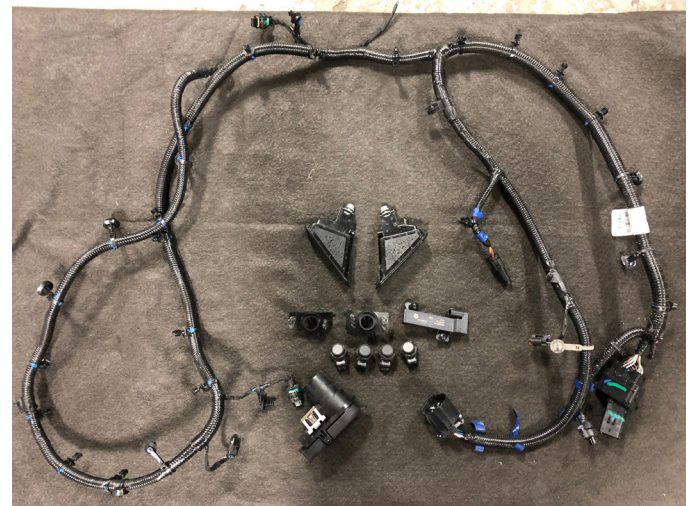

INSTALLATION

11. Using the supplied rubber grommets, insert them into the six (6) sensor openings in the shell of the bumper. (21973)(50195-HW)(Figure 12)

NOTE: If your vehicle doesn't have the side sensors, plug the two (2) unused sensor grommets in the wings with the included plastic plugs. Align the plastic plug, sensor grommet and soft end of hammer, slap the other end of hammer to seat the plastic grommet into the hole. (50195-HW)(Figure 13)

12. Install the four (4) or six (6) OEM sensors into the rubber grommets. (50189-HW) (Figure 14-15)

NOTE: Insertion of sensor into the rubber grommet is made easier by first wetting the rubber grommet with water, then while stretching the rubber grommet into an oval shape roll the sensor into position. Oil should not be used as a lubrication for the grommet as oil will not dry out. (Figure 14)

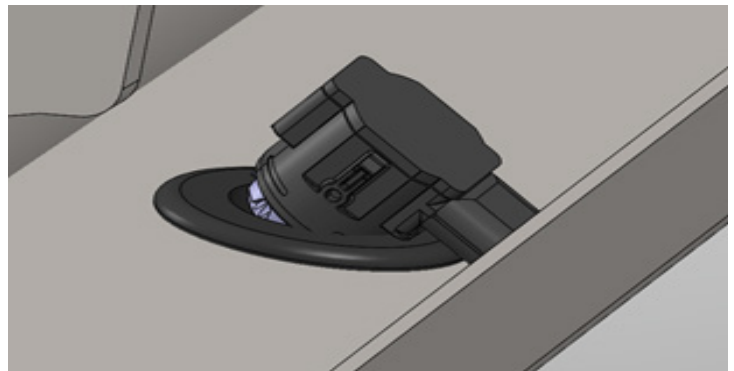

NOTE: The reverse lights (61360) and grommets (61361) install in the same manner as the OEM sensors do but are only provided with the tread plate version of this bumper. Install the reverse lights now if applicable.

13. Install the tag light into the 1 ¼" hole in the center section.

14. Using a drill and a #16 Drill Bit (.177"), drill The OEM Trailer Hitch Plug using in the locations pointed out with arrows below. Use care to drill directly in the center of the circles in the plastic. (Figure 16-17)

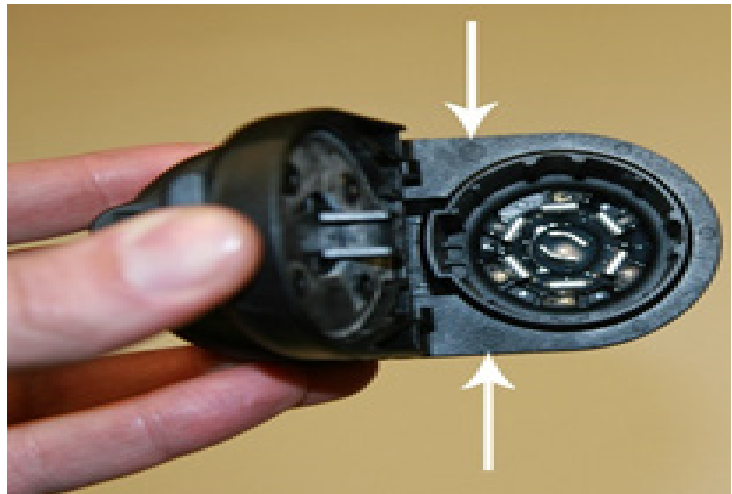

15. Using a 3/32" Allen key and 11/32" socket wrench, install the Trailer Plug into the Cutout in the new bumper using the #8-32 button head bolt, flat washer and #8-32 Nyloc nut. (50189-HW)

16. Using zip ties, begin securing the factory wiring harness as shown. (Figure 20-21)

NOTE: Figure 21 shows the wiring harness no-go zone in marked out. The factory hitch structure occupies this area.

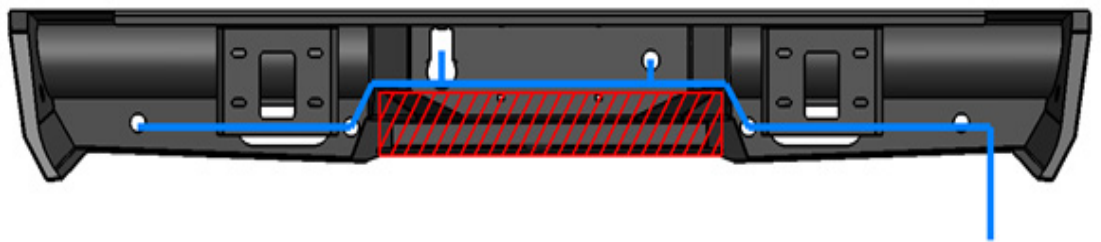

17. Connect the factory wiring harness to all the sensors and trailer plug.

18. Splice the Tag light provided to the factory wiring harness

NOTE: polarity doesn't matter when wiring up this led tag light. (Figure 22)

19. Using a dead blow hammer, bend the OEM bumper center mounting plate back towards the spare tire as the studs on that plate will interfere your new bumper. (Figure 23)

20. With assistance, lift and sit the bumper on the center hitch plate leaving a uniform gap all around the bumper to vehicle and loosely install the provided four (4) 7/16"-14 x 1.25" yellow zinc hex bolt, yellow zinc flat washers,

21. Loosely install the factory OEM bolt with the provided four (4) 5/16" clear zinc fender washers. (50195-HW)

22. Center the bumper with the vehicle and using a 10mm wrench, fully tighten down the four (4) factory OEM bolts with fender washers.

23. Using a 5/8" and 11/16" wrench, fully tighten down the four (4) 7/16" bolt stacks.

24. Reconnect the factory wiring harness to the vehicle and test all your lights and sensors.

25. Install the provided four (4) ¼" Nylon license plate Nuts with License plate. (50195-HW) (Figure 27)



26. Wire the reverse lights to your liking If applicable
