# INSTALLATION MANUAL

#### **GRAB N' GO MOLLE POCKET**

21+ FORD BRONCO MPBR-03



## **TOOLS** REQUIRED

- Trim Clip Tool
- #4 Allen Bit
- 17/64" Drill Bit
- Sharpie/Marker

## **SKILL** LEVEL

- Novice

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Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself.

## TIME REQUIRED

#### - .5 Hour

Time to install this should only take about half an hour.

**STEP 1** Prior to beginning the install guide, read through the guide completely to see how the factory panel is removed.

Take note of the style and location of each clip and the order and process in which they are removed.

It must be removed carefully using the below steps. Deviating from the steps may result in broken trim clips.

If any of the factory trim clips break, finishing installation may be very difficult and it may impact the sturdiness of the Grab n' Go Pocket.







**STEP 2** | Looking at the interior of the tailgate, there are three push style clips located along the left edge of the trim panel.







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


**STEP 3** There is one latch clip which slips behind the metal lip on the right side of the top edge.

Pictured on the right is a broken latch clip and unbroken latch clip for reference..

A broken latch clip like this will occur when you release the three push clips along the left side of the trim and remove the panel incorrectly.









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**STEP 4** There are two hinge like clips located along the right edge of the trim panel towards the middle and bottom.







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STEP 5 | To remove the panel correctly, without breaking and clips, use a trim clip tool carefully remove the push clips located along the left edge. Pictured in step 1.

It may be necessary to start at the top or bottom corner in order to get the tool underneath the trim. Just be sure to shift it to left edge as soon as its under the trim.

#### As the clips are released, **DO NOT PULL THE PANEL AWAY FROM THE TAILGATE.**

Notice in the second picture how as the clips are released, a second hand is being used to hold the panel close to the tailgate to avoid breaking the latch clip.

Gently slide panel down and to the left once the push clips are unfastened.

Note: It may be helpful to have a second person apply pressure to the right edge and upper right corner while working to unfasten the push clips.











**STEP 6** | Lay the pocket over the factory trim and align them.



**STEP 7** | Mark the mounting holes using a sharpie, and do not let the pocket and panel shift.



**STEP 8** | Remove the pocket, and using a 17/64" drill bit, carefully drill the marked mounting holes.







STEP 9 | Using the provided M6 hardware with a #4 allen bit, secure the pocket to the trim.



STEP 10 | To re-install the trim panel, guide it gently up and to the right until they latch and hinge clips slip behind the metal edge.

Then press the push clips into place by pressing the left side of the trim. Use force to ensure they are clipped in securely.









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STEP 11 | Congrats! You are finished with the install of the 21+ Bronco Grab N' Go Molle Pocket.
