- Ratchet
- -3mm, 4mm Allen Bit
- -10mm Wrench
- -T50 Torx Bit

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate
- -1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

TIME REQUIRED

- 1.5 Hour

Time to install this should only take about an hour and a half.

STEP 1 | Install the smaller bracket using the provided M6 hardware. All M6 hardware will be finger tight until the end of install.

Pictured is assembly and installation of the passenger side panel.


There are a few ways to identify passenger/ driver side panels.

Lay out both panels so that so the large side is on your left, and the smaller side is on the right. The panel with the logo that reads left to right correctly is the passenger side panel.

Place them up to your vehicle to visually reference the logo and seatbelt mounting bracket. Note how the bracket that mounts on the tub is angled so the molle panel is parallel with the roll bar.














STEP 2 | Install and secure the bumpstop using the provided M4 hardware and a 3mm allen bit. The bump stop should be installed on the same side as the smaller seatbelt mounting bracket.



STEP 3 | Install the larger bracket on the side opposite the bumpstop/seatbelt mounting bracket using provided M6 hardware.

Identify the correct bracket by lining up the smaller/shorter corner with the logo. The logo will be covered by this bracket and should read backwards.

Finger-tight only.



STEP 4 | Moving to the interior of the vehicle, remove the plastic trim on the seat belt pulley.

Use a T50 to remove the bolt securing the seatbelt.










STEP 5 Use a T50 to remove the two bolts securing the hardtop, located closest to the front of the vehicle.



STEP 6 | Maneuver the panel into the approximate location of install and very loosely secure it with the factory hardtop bolts by hand.




STEP 7 | Move the seatbelt bracket into place, and then install the seatbelt over it.

It may be necessary to apply some force to get the bracket into position.

Secure the bracket with the seat belt using a T50 and the factory bolt. Torque to 24 ft-lbs with a dab of blue loctite.









STEP 8 | Finish securing the factory hardtop bolts with a T50.



Secure all M6 hardware with 4mm allen bit and 10mm wrench.

Replace plastic trim on the seat belt.





STEP 9 | You are now finished installing your new 2018+ JL Jeep Wrangler Rear Window Interior Molle Panel.
