# Jeep Grand Cherokee(ZJ) Rear Upper Door Armor

## \*Please Dry Fit Before Paint/Powder Coat\*

### **Preparation-**

- 1) Start by locating the three Phillips head screws that secure the inner door panel in place *You Will Need:* 
  - Phillips head screwdriver
- 2) Remove the inner door panel
- 3) Unplug the window control panel and pull the door handle to remove the plastic cover that contains the door handle and the lock mechanism
- 4) Place the door armor on the door and mark where the holes are to be drilled

### You Will Need:

- Any type of permanent marker
- 5) Drill all marks completely through to 5/16"

### You Will Need:

- 5/16" twist drill bit
- Any type of drill

### **Installation-**

### All installation steps are the same for both driver's and passenger side of the vehicle

- 1) Set the door armor in place making sure that all holes are aligned
- 2) Using the provided hardware, insert the bolts through the armor and the door and snug the bolts enough to hold the armor in place

### You Will Need:

- Assorted Allen keys
- 5/16" wrench
- 3) Tighten all the bolts and nuts evenly once the armor is centered

### You Will Need:

- Assorted Allen keys
- 5/16" wrench
- 4) Once all bolts are fully tightened, you may plug in the window controls and reinstall the inner door panel
